### **\*\*\*NOTE: THIS PARADE IS NON-EQUESTRIAN**

- 1. All motorized entries must be operated by a licensed driver.
- 2. Entrants under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. NO persons will be allowed to ride on the outside of autos or wagons protected seating inside truck or wagon bed is ok.
- 4. All entrants agree to maintain suitable insurance which will respond on their behalf and the City's behalf, for any injury or damage which occurs.
- 5. The entrants also agree they are participating in the parade at their own risk and agree to hold the city harmless for any injury or damage that may occur.
